Runway 9-27, Taxiway B&C Connectors, and Main Apron Pavement Rehabilitation Antonio Rivera Rodriguez Airport (VQS) Vieques, Puerto Rico

In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 8981 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The project consists of the pavement rehabilitation of Runway 9-27, Taxiway Bravo and the Main Apron at the Antonio Rivera Rodriguez Airport (VQS) on the island of Vieques, Puerto Rico. The Runway 9-27, Taxiway B, and Main Apron pavement rehabilitation includes the mill and overlay of the Asphalt Concrete (AC) pavement and the pavement rehabilitation of several taxiway connectors to match existing elevations. The scope of work also includes airfield lightning, signage and visual aids modifications, drainage preservation, and pavement markings. The scope of work also includes the pavement demolition of the existing Taxiway Charlie which will be eliminated from the airport taxiway system. These scope items are in accordance with contract documents and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) technical specifications.

Bidders of this project shall mail the Proposal via US Postal Service, IN HARD COPY AND ELECTRONIC COPY (CD OR USB) in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, postmarked by **June 4, 2020**.

Due to the COVID-19 situation the following steps will be used to register on the bid and obtain the bidding documents:

- Download a **Bidders Registration, Consent and Release FOR ONLINE BID** Form (available at www.prpa.pr.gov).
- Pay a non-refundable amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority by calling (787)-729-8715 Extension 3332 or (787) 729-8859, Monday through Friday from 7:30 AM - 4:00 PM. VISA, Master Card or Discover are accepted. Cash will not be accepted.
- Request the bidding documents to the following email address Bid1390@prpa.pr.gov, including **Bidders Registration, Consent and Release FOR ONLINE BID** with the payment receipt number.
- Bid registration shall be permitted until **May 26, 2020 2:00 PM**.

Bidders are advised that they must be registered as possessors of the contract documents for the project and all such amendments.

A non-mandatory virtual pre-bid meeting will be held using **Microsoft Teams Application** on **May 13, 2020 at 1:00 PM** (Local PR Time). Any party interested in attending the meeting shall request participation by sending an email to Bid1390@prpa.pr.gov. PRPA strongly encourages prospective bidders to attend the pre-bid conference.

The Bid Opening will take place virtually on **June 9, 2020 at 10:00 AM** through Microsoft Teams Application. ALL BIDS RECEIVED WILL BE PUBLICLY OPENED AND READ ALOUD VIRTUALLY BY THE BIDS BOARD.

The project is conditioned upon the receipt of federal funding under provisions of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP). Certain mandatory federal requirements apply to this solicitation and will be made part of any contract awarded.
