In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 7496 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The project consists of an interior remodeling of the terminal building with the main objective to create an expansion and rearrangement of the departure lounge to accommodate an increase in scheduled airline traffic. The works shall be done as per drawings, specifications and general contract conditions.

Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until October 29, 2019 at 10:00 AM. A non-compulsory pre-bid conference will be held on October 16, 2019 at 2:00PM the Puerto Rico Port Authority Engineering Conference Room, PRPA Engineering Building, 2nd floor, Lindbergh Street, Isla Grande, PR.

The Drawings, Specifications and other contract documents for this project, on electronic format, can be obtained at the Engineering Bureau Building of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office, Phone Number (787) 729-8715 extension 3219, from October 7 until October 25, 2019 by paying a nonrefundable amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) in cash or certified check to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority. Documents will be available for review at the PRPA Engineering Offices. Bidders are advised that they must be registered as possessors of the contract documents for the project and possessors of all such amendments.

All bids received, will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Bids Board at the Conference Room, PRPA Engineering Building, 2nd floor, Lindbergh Street, Isla Grande, on the same day of the Bid Opening.

The successful bidder must submit to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority the required bonds, insurance, policies, certificate of having filed an income tax return statement to the Puerto Rico Treasury Department for the last five years, certificate of debts to the Government of Puerto Rico, certificate of payment of property taxes (CRIM), certificate of payment of unemployment insurance, temporal incapacity and social security for drivers, etc., and shall execute the construction contract within ten (10) working days after the date of the Notice of Award.
