In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 8981 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The project consists of the rehabilitation of the Runway 09-27 on the Eugenio María de Hostos Airport, Mayagüez, Puerto Rico. The Runway 09-27 rehabilitation includes the mill and overlay of the Asphalt Concrete pavement, including the pavement rehabilitation of the Taxiway connectors. Installation of new electrical lighting and signage systems, pavement demolition, horizontal and vertical pavement geometric changes, and pavement markings are also part of the scope. All in accordance with contract documents and technical specifications.


Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until June 20, 2019 at 10:00 AM. (Local PR Time). A pre-bid conference will be held on June 11 at 1:30 P.M (Local PR Time) at the Conference Room of the Engineering Bureau Building at Isla Grande, San Juan, PR. PRPA strongly encourages prospective bidders to attend the pre-bid conference.

The Drawings, Specifications and other contract documents for this project, on electronic format, can be obtained 72 hours before the bid opening day at the Engineering Bureau Building of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Central Office, Phone Number (787) 729-8715 extension 3187, by paying a nonrefundable amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) in cash or certified check to the Puerto Rico Ports Authority. Bidders are advised that they must be registered as possessors of the contract documents for the project and possessors of all such amendments.

All bids received, will be publicly opened and read aloud by the Bids Board at the Conference Room of the Puerto Rico Ports Authority Engineering Bureau Building at Isla Grande, San Juan, PR, at the same day of the Bid Opening. The project is conditioned upon the receipt of federal funding under provisions of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program (AIP). Certain mandatory federal requirements apply to this solicitation and will be made part of any contract awarded. The Qualified Bidder must comply with all federal regulations, including, but not limited, to Access to Records and Reports (Reference: 2 CFR § 200.326, 2 CFR § 200.333), affirmative action requirement (Reference: 41 CFR part 60-4, Executive Order 11246), Breach of Contract Terms.
