In accordance with Act 125 of May 7, 1942, as amended, and Regulation 8981 of PRPA Bids and Request for Proposals, the Puerto Rico Ports Authority (PRPA) is requesting competitive bids from contractors, for the project referenced above.

The project objective is to enhance Airport terminal of the Benjamín Rivera Noriega Airport at Municipality of Culebra (CPX) in response to Coronavirus pandemic. This project will be funded by the Airport Coronavirus Grant Program (ACRGP), Grant No. 3-72-0009-017-2021.

This project consists of the following tasks: General works on existing exhaust system; Install a new air conditioning system at waiting and office area (PRPA & US CUSTOM); Bathrooms equipment replacement; Access doors replacement; Install new air curtains; Install square ornamental wall blocks sealing; Provide portable air purification units; Install new maintenance and service fixed ladder with safety cage; Remove, dispose and replace existing roof deck at storage room; Provide new sanitizing floor mats; And realize necessary electrical improvements.


Bidders of this project shall submit the Proposal in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders contained in the Contract Documents, until **January 14, 2022 at 10:30 A.M.** (Local PR Time). A noncompulsory pre-bid and site visit conference will be held **December 22, 2021 at 10:30 A.M.** on (Local PR Time) at Benjamin Rivera Noriega Airport (CPX), Culebra, PR. PRPA strongly encourages prospective bidders to attend the pre-bid conference and site visit on the airport.
